

**REGULATIONS OF THE II INTERNATIONAL OUTDOOR SCULPTURE EVENT  
AT A&A EUROPEAN SCULPTURE PARK  
PABIANICE 2012**

**§ 1**

The organizer - A&A Marketing - is arranging the II International Outdoor Sculpture Event - "Pabianice 2012" from May 21, 2012 to June 2, 2012. The organizer appoints Ms Dorota Tomaszewska as the Commissioner of the event. The place of the event is A&A European Sculpture Park, located at Grota Roweckiego 8a in Pabianice in Poland. Outdoor sculpture event is not thematic. Artists are free to choose topics of their work.

**§ 2**

Outdoor sculpture event will be held regardless of weather conditions. Artists will work in the space provided by the Organizer in the Park. There is a possibility to work both in the open or indoor space prior arrangement with the Organizer required. The organizer reserves the right to cancel the outdoor sculpture event if circumstances preventing event come up. In such case participants will be immediately notified. The artist, who is selected for the event and cannot take part in it personally, has the right to create a sculpture outside the outdoor sculpture event after prior agreement with the Organizer.

**§ 3**

From 5 to 10 people invited and selected by the Commissioner will take part in the outdoor sculpture event.

**§ 4**

Sculptures will be made of different materials. The organizer provides materials after consultation with the artist and final approval. If carving tools not owned by the Artist are needed, the Organizer is obliged to organize the tools after consultation with the Artist and if he considers it as appropriate. Moreover the technical assistance is provided in the form of two employed workers.

**§ 5**

Participants of the event are obliged to create sculptures in the preferred size: 2 meters high (+/- 10%), with exceptions allowed after the Organizer's approval. Absolute delivery time for finished work is 8.00 p.m. on June 3, 2012. If a sculpture is not finished on time, the Organizer reserves a right to demand penalty fee -1000 zł and the return of incurred expenses as well as inform the public which artist has not finished his sculpture, unless the artist shows justified reasons that did not allow him to carry out his obligation.

**§ 6**

On the grounds of a separate contract:

1. Each participant agrees to donate the sculpture made during the event to the Organizer.
2. The Organizer becomes the owner of the sculptures and reserves the right to use them. The sculptures become part of the A&A European Sculpture Park at Grota Roweckiego 8a in Pabianice.
3. If circumstances associated with the need to develop the Park arise in future, the Organizer has the right to manage the created works in any way.
4. Artists waive copyrights for created works.
5. Artists agree to transfer to the Organizer the rights to any photographs of themselves or their sculptures, which will be used to promote the Park and will be published for information or advertising. For this purpose the Artist allows the Organizer to use his image,

**§ 7**

The Organizer provides participants with food and accommodation (accommodation does not apply to artists living in Łódź and its vicinity) for the duration of the event.

**§ 8**

Participants are obliged to have personal accident and third party insurance for the duration of the event and to provide the Organizer with insurance confirmation.

**§ 9**

The Organizer is obliged to publish the image of the artist in the A&A European Sculpture Park catalogue and on the website [www.park-rzezby.pl](http://www.park-rzezby.pl). The organizer also provides media publicity in the form of information in local media and in nationwide media, as possible. In addition, the artist gets an invitation for the ceremonial unveiling of sculptures (attendance of about 1000 people last year), which takes place on June 3, 2012 and materials for CV in the form of photos from the outdoor sculpture event and the ceremonial unveiling of sculptures.

#### **§ 10**

Participants invited for the event are required to confirm definitively their participation till February 29, 2012 with the application and the outdoor sculpture event regulations signed.

It is also the last date of submission of sculpture designs. The design should take the form of sculpture drawing/sketch in scale of about 1/10 in relation to actual size. Models and photographs can also be sent. The design should be completed by information about the proposed title of work, a brief discussion of artistic intentions and the image of the artist - to be placed on the website. Provided materials are left to the Organizer, who is obliged to use them only in connection with the park. All of the above information can be sent to:

#### **§ 11**

1. Final selection of sculptures and artists for this year's Outdoor Sculpture Event will be announced till March 15, 2012
2. Selected artists will be sent two copies of contract described in § 6 of these regulations. A signed copy should be returned to the Organizer to March 30, 2012. Not sending a signed copy is understood as resignation from participation in the event, which entitles the Organizer to replace the artist with someone else.

#### **§ 12**

After the event the Organizer is obliged to publish a catalogue that will contain photographs of the works and participants as well as information about their work based on the contents provided by the artists or from general sources. Each participant will receive 5 copies of the catalogue for his disposal.

#### **§ 13**

On behalf of the Organizer the work during the event is coordinated by appointed Commissioner.

#### **§ 14**

Signing the regulations confirms the approval of stated rules.
